The audio, lighting and A/V inventory will meet most contemporary theatrical requirements. It features a tension wire grid that allows easy overhead access resulting in a fast and efficient bump-in and lighting focus.

Seating Capacity and Studio Configurations/Modes

The Studio can be configured into modes that best suit the hirer's.

Standard mode is Front On (210 capacity).


Please note the approximate extra hours for set up.

284 capacity in Thrust mode with side seating banks added to Front On mode.

12 hours (eg: 4 staff x 3 hours) at current rates as described in Item 8 above to set up Thrust and

12 hours (eg: 4 staff x 3 hours) at current rates as described in Item 8 to return to Front On mode.

350 capacity in Reduced Stage mode – with a raised stage placed upstage and loose seating placed on the floor. 16 hours (eg: 4 staff x 4 hours) at current rates as described in Item 8 above to set up Reduced Stage and 16 hours (eg: 4 staff x 3 hours) at current rates as described in Item 8 to return to Front On mode. Bespoke seating configurations can be achieved and arranged – please enquire for more details and charges.

Other Charges

Cleaning \$155 per performance (cleaning charges are subject to change)

Technical Staff Theatre Royal technicians are charged at the following rates -

\$52 per hour, normal time (Minimum 3 hour call Mon to Sat, minimum 4 hour call

Sundays and public holidays)

\$82 per hour overtime, Sundays, Public Holidays and hours between midnight and 7am

One Theatre Royal technician must be engaged prior to and during a performance

Front of House Staff

Theatre Royal Front of House staff are charged at the following rates -

\$48 per hour normal time (Minimum 3 hour call Mon to Sat, minimum 4 hour call

Sundays and public holidays)

\$76 per hour overtime, Sundays, Public Holidays and hours between midnight and 7am

One Theatre Royal Front of House staff must be engaged prior to and during a performance

Please note

'Normal time' is defined as Monday through Saturday 7am - 12 midnight;

'Overtime' is defined as Midnight - 7am and all day Sundays and public holidays.

Staff must receive a 10 hour break between finishing work on one day and commencing work on the next day.

Both Technical and FOH staff are entitled to a meal break of at least 30 minutes

after 5 hours continuous work. Hirers who fail to schedule appropriate breaks will any penalties paid to staff.

Light and power As metered: \$0.15 per KwH

Piano (Yamaha Upright) \$70 per performance, plus tuning if required (approx \$275)
Piano (Yamaha C7) \$120 per performance, plus tuning if required (approx \$275)

Live Performance Australia (LPA) Industry Service Fee

An Industry Service Fee of \$41 or \$82 per performance (dependant on capacity) shall be paid; this fee is collected and remitted in full to Live Performance Australia.

Some educational, community arts, charities, amateur theatrical and cultural, non commercial projects are exempt. Where an Exemption has been agreed, LPA will provide a letter to the producer/promoter confirming the exemption.

The Industry Service Fee is adjusted annually by the LPA and is subject to change

Ticket Sales

Ticket sales cannot commence until the hire contract is signed and the deposit (bond) has been received. All ticket sales must be handled by the Theatre Royal box office. The *Booking Fee* is a sliding scale based on your ticket price (please refer to the table below). Credit card transactions attract a surcharge of 2.5% which is charged to the hirer.

Merchandise Sales

A commission of 10% of the gross proceeds of program and merchandise sales will be paid by the hirer to the Theatre Royal.
